

Завершилось трехдневное совещание группы экспертов по подготовке итогового документа «Стратегия МГП-IX на период 2022-2029 гг.».

Встреча, организованная Секретариатом МГП ЮНЕСКО, прошла 2-4 июня 2021г. в формате зумм-конференции. В результате работы группы экспертов согласованы все замечания и дополнения к Проекту Стратегии МГП-IX, которые были сформулированы странами-членами Межправительственного Совета МГП в ходе подготовки итогового документа в 2020-2021 гг. В работе совещания активное участие приняли члены Национального комитета РФ С.А.Журавлев (ГГИ), М.В.Болгов (ИВП РАН), Горелиц О.В. (ГОИН) и А.Чиркова (Постоянное Представительство России при ЮНЕСКО). Предложения НК РФ были приняты группой экспертов и включены в итоговый документ.

167> The gap between water policies and its management can become great, where if it is not always considered in an integrated and inclusive way, becomes even greater when the voices of women, youth, indigenous groups, racial or ethnic minorities, lower income social classes or migrants are not included in decision-making processes related to investments that affect water resources in their daily lives.¶

168> Social participation (women, youth, indigenous groups, national minorities and others), lower income social classes or migrants are not included in decision-making processes related to investments that affect water resources in their daily lives [consider placing elsewhere may lead to is a means of improving water accountability and responsibility and, when properly achieved, can lead to conscientious and inclusive resource management. A central component of participation is gender equality in all decision-making instances. Participatory management also includes the enabling of citizen science, user-centred design, youth and community participation. Special attention should also be given to the actual water resource user groups that in the end have to deal with the resulting water management decisions and practices. Many water-related inequalities are due to power relations. By working together in partnerships, more wide-ranging and accepted impacts can be achieved.¶
